Pedestrian Safety

- VV, CS and Nilan attended D5 leadership meeting
 - Pedestrian safety was addressed, but in terms of limited funds for traffic safety improvements and that priorities can be affected by resident involvement
 - Vision zero grant is a major funding source, but our location is not top priority b/c there are lots of problem areas
- Recap of 2/12 meeting with city officials to discuss collision at Oregon and Freeport
 - Crosswalk was removed because research and federal guidelines show that it's more dangerous for that type of street and level of traffic than no crosswalk.
 - Other improvements to make crossing safer will take time and funding, no clear timeline. Suggestions are a hawk light for pedestrians, street narrowing.
 - Short term solutions:
 - Do traffic study to find out if reducing speed limit from that intersection south to Meadowview
 - Put in speed limit signs with radar of current speed have been ordered, will be installed within 5 weeks
 - Do community education of safer crossings at Fruitridge and Irvin, outreach to schools and neighborhoods that use it

- Increased police presence for enforcement of speed limits, suggested times are at school start and end
- Azia suggested meeting with Eric Poon, traffic investigator
- · Goals for neighborhood involvement
 - Discussion at general meeting
 - Forming a committee
 - o Reach out to SLPNA ask Dylan for contact info
 - Find out if schools/PTAs are involved at LDV and HP

Crime

- Azia:
 - City has bait car program to catch car thefts, can bring it to our neighborhood if we suggest intersections. Same for bait packages.
 - City will do increased patrols of HP

Tree Project Update: CS

- Ask a tree expert event was on Sunday
- CS is gathering members for a steering committee
- CS is meeting with Torin and Supervisor Kennedy to discuss funding for the project – for workshops, tree removal, digging and planting, block party
- Looking for matching funds
- March fundraiser coming up (date TBD) with Two Rivers and Sutterville Bicycle
