#### Schenirer's Office Releases Gate Schedule for School Grounds Access

As the year is coming to an end, we'd like to wish everyone Happy Holidays! We know that as the holidays roll around there is more free time to take the kids out to play and take little Max on a walk around the neighborhood. This holiday season we want to make sure everyone is on the same page, so we thought we'd go over some agreements between the community and the schools about the shared use of the Leonardo da Vinci and Hollywood Park Elementary School grounds.

First off, it is important to note that all gates will be locked at these schools grounds while school is not in session during the holidays (Nov. 25-29 & Dec. 23-Jan. 3). Please keep in mind that the fields are SCUSD property and not a city-owned park and the city does not pay any funds to maintain the park. Much like fire and police stations, tax dollar contributions do not permit access to these grounds. However, Principal Tenley and Principal Davis have worked with the community to find some common ground.

#### Leonardo da Vinci Current Gate Schedule (Monday – Friday):

Both gates at the back of the field are unlocked from 7:00 am to 9:15 am, locked during school hours from 9:15 am to 2:45 pm, and locked again at 4:30 pm. The gate/fence coming into the back of the school parking lot is open after school.

#### Hollywood Park Current Gate Schedule (Monday-Friday):

Gates that lead to the field are unlocked from 7:00 am to 9:00 am, locked during school hours from 9:00 am to 3:12 pm, and locked again at 4:30 pm. The gate/fence coming into the back of the school parking lot is open after school.

\*Please note that the Sacramento City Unified School District is working on developing a larger district-wide policy that will require a 5-week trial period. Updates are to follow.

Remember, all owners must clean up after their pets and pets must remain on-leash and under their owner's supervision. If little Max eats one too many candy canes (not recommended) and needs to run off some extra energy, there is a dog park off Fruitridge Rd. designed for off-leash play. Please remember that these grounds are a part of your community and should be treated as such!


# Neighborhood Business Spotlight: Centennial Christian Preschool
